I report on the accounts of the Charity for the year ending 31 August 2024, which are set out below.

Responsibilities of Trustees and Examiner – The trustees consider that an audit is not required for this year under section 43(2) of the Charities Act 1993 (the Act) and that an independent examination is needed.
